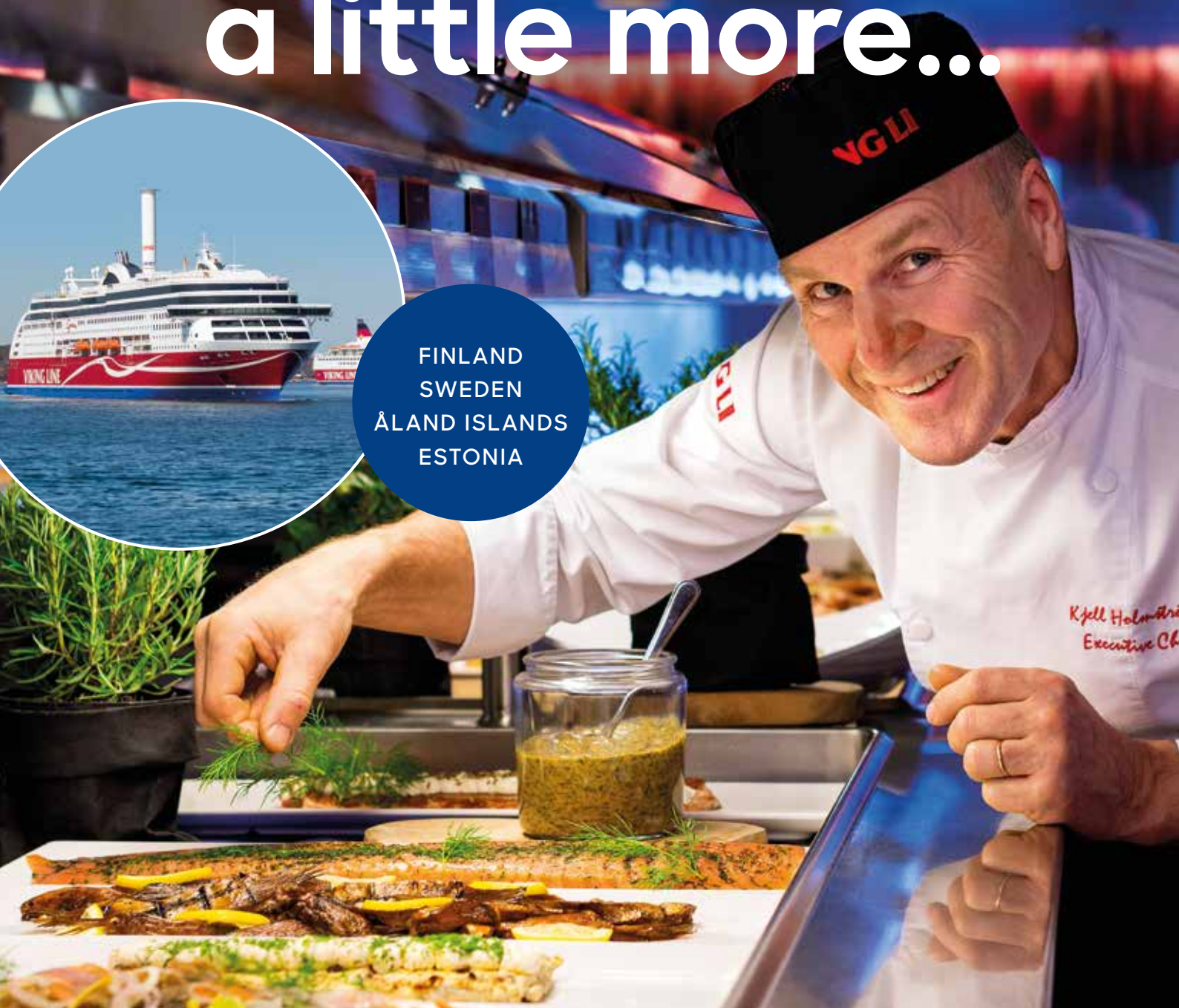

## Viking Line

- ▶ Family-owned since 1959
- ▶ Head office located in Mariehamn (Åland Islands)
- ▶ Listed on NASDAQ Helsinki since 1995
- ▶ 7 vessels connecting Sweden, Finland and Estonia
- ▶ In 2017 Viking Line had about 2,900 employees in 4 different countries

Viking Grace is the world's first large passenger ship that uses liquefied natural gas (LNG) as fuel. With the help of LNG, the ship's nitrogen exhausts and particles are decreased by 85% and greenhouse gases by 15%. The sulphur exhaust level will be practically zero.

Since April 2018 Viking Grace is the first large passenger ship worldwide to be equipped with a rotor sail for the utilisation of wind power. This will cut fuel consumption by 300 t and reduce emissions by up to 900 t annually.



The M/S Seagas was specially built for ship-to-ship refueling for Viking Grace and has already performed its 1000<sup>th</sup> refuelling in 2016. Seagas is the first vessel of its kind.

Our new energy-efficient vessel will be 218 metres in length and have a gross registered tonnage of about 63,000 tonnes.

Energy efficiency will be very important in planning and building the ship. Viking Line engages Scandinavian architects for the interior design.

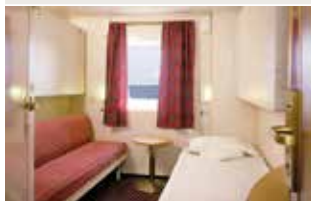

# Safety, Security and Environmental Work

## Safety on board

- ▶ On-board navigation and safety equipment meets the latest standards
- ▶ Fast rescue boats, self-righting life rafts and new evacuation systems
- ▶ All vessels are equipped with Voyage Data Recorder (VDR) systems
- ▶ Safety training and drills take place regularly on board Viking Line vessels

## Viking Line's ships

- ▶ Environmentally certified according to ISO 14001 international standards by the independent certification body
- ▶ All our ships use "green fuel"
- ▶ International fuel-saving programme, harnessing of energy from exhausts as well as re-using waste heat
- ▶ All vessels meet the stability standards of the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS 90) and the Stockholm Agreement
- ▶ Land-based power supply used in harbours

## Environment

- ▶ Viking Line does not discharge ANY waste water into the Baltic Sea
- ▶ In 2017, waste heat from the vessel's engines was converted into 483.700 kWh of clean electricity
- ▶ Recycled from our vessels in 2017:
  - > 20 tons of plastic
  - > 8 tons of aluminum
  - > 1,500 tons of used oils
  - > 423 tons of glass packaging
  - > 633 tons paper and cardboard
  - > Food waste from Viking Grace, Gabriella, Mariella and XPRS generated biogas equivalent to 97,000 liters of petrol in 2017
- ▶ Viking Line has received several awards for its environmental commitment

90% of exports and 70% of imports are transported by ship in Finland





# Did you know?

## Our Ships

- ▶ 6.8 mill. passengers/year
- ▶ Since 1959 a total of:
  - > 213 mill. passengers
  - > 21 mill. cars and
  - > 4 mill. cargo units have been transported on our ships
- ▶ More than 130,000 cargo units/year
- ▶ M/S Viking Grace is the first LNG passenger ship world wide
- ▶ From a distance of 100 metres, the noise level of Viking Grace is at 50 decibels – equivalent to a fridge
- ▶ Has been fitted with a rotor sail in April 2018 to save another 900 tons of fuel/year

## On Board

- ▶ Approx. 6 mill. cups of organic coffee are served on our vessels per year
- ▶ Viking Line wins Swedish Service Score award for fourth time
- ▶ Viking Grace has a snow cave on board
- ▶ Total conference capacity on Viking Grace is approx. 550 seats
- ▶ World's first only floating Victoria's Secret Beauty & Accessories shop on Viking Grace

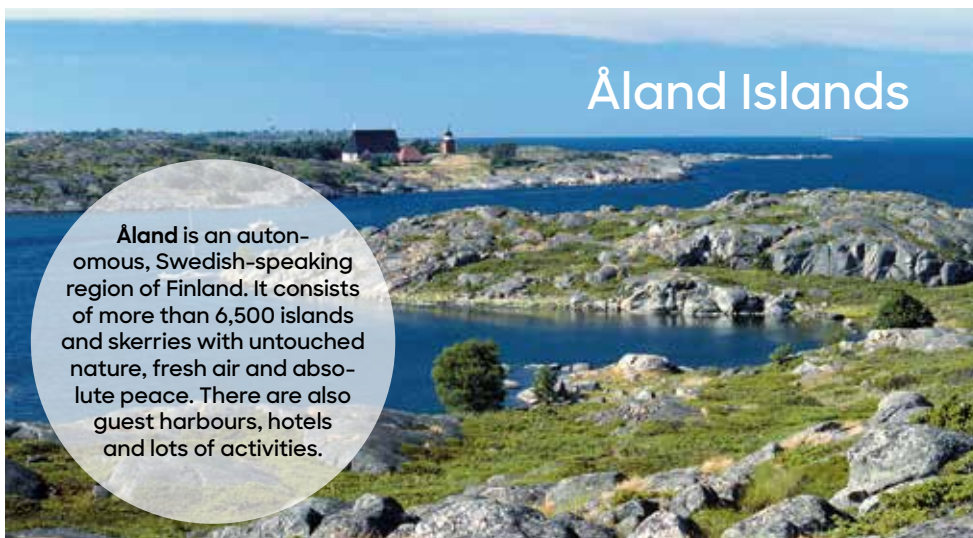
